Registered Nurse – OTN and Clinic
Full time (35 hours/week) 1 year contract

South-East Ottawa Community Health Centre (SEOCHC) is a non-profit, community-governed organization that provides a range of multi-disciplinary services to clients, including primary care, health promotion, social services, community and resource development, home support and advocacy to address the social determinants of health. SEOCHC particularly responds to persons who face barriers to accessing health and social services and who live in South-East Ottawa. Our services and programs are designed to meet the needs of our community.

We are seeking a highly-skilled Registered Nurse (RN) to work in our Ontario Telemedicine Network (OTN) program (60% of the time) and our primary care clinic (40% of the time) as a member of an inter-professional team. OTN supports clients in accessing virtual care through videoconferencing, remote monitoring, clinical applications, web-based solutions, etc. The Nurse will plan, coordinate, support and promote the effective delivery of these solutions for clients and providers. In the clinic, the Nurse will work with physicians, nurse practitioners, nurses, administrative staff, and allied health professionals to provide comprehensive ongoing primary care.

The Registered Nurse will ensure delivery of high quality virtual care in collaboration with other OTN hub sites in the region. The RN will oversee all virtual care activities (i.e. clinical, educational, and administrative) and work closely with the OTN Technical Administrator. The RN will be tasked with identification of clinical gaps and client needs that could be supported via OTN. The RN will work with the Director of Health Services to set targets, identify areas of growth, develop new programs, implement and evaluate programs and initiatives.

Due the pandemic, we conduct daily infection prevention screening of all clients and staff coming to our Centre to help prevent exposures to COVID-19. We provide both virtual and face-to-face visits to our clients. This role includes conducting home visits with clients requiring OTN and other virtual care supports. Prior to home visits, daily infection prevention screening of clients and workers is conducted to help prevent exposures to COVID-19.

- Comfortable working in a rapidly changing health care environment with multiple partners
- Interest in application of technology in health care environment
- Ability to advocate for the integration of virtual care across the organization and externally
- Innovative with the ability to problem solve quickly, strategically, and creatively
- Superior organizational skills and ability to set priorities
- Experience working with medical specialists and other healthcare professionals
- An understanding of the field of virtual care, or a willingness to learn

- Nursing Degree - Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BScN).
- Certification and member in good standing with the College of Nurses of Ontario (CNO).
- Basic CPR certification required.
- Recent nursing experience, preferably in a community-based setting
- Fluency in English and French language preferred; other languages an asset
- Valid vulnerable sector police screening.
- Valid Ontario Driver's license and reliable access to a vehicle.
- Proficiency in the use of computers and electronic medical records
- Ability to work flexible hours
