Crossroads Children's Mental Health Centre (CCMHC) provides a wide range of mental health services for children under the age of 12 and their families.

We are currently recruiting casuals for our Day Treatment Program.

### CCMHC Day Treatment Program

#### **Education and Treatment for children in the classroom.**

Day treatment is a one to two-year program for children who, because of their mental health concerns, are unable to be successful in a regular classroom setting.

Our day treatment team provides a combination of education and mental health treatment so children can build skills that will help them return to and thrive at their community school.

**Casual positions require daytime availability. This is an on-call position and at times will require replacing staff with little to no notice.**

### QUALIFICATIONS

- Child & Youth Worker diploma or bachelor's degree in social work, psychology, or equivalent degree.
- A broad knowledge of the principles of treatment, the developmental and care needs of children and family dynamics.

- Awareness, knowledge, and ability to deliver culturally safe services.
- Experience in a school setting preferred.
- Training in the Collaborative Problem Solving approach considered an asset.
