Registered Nurse – COVID-19 Response
Full time (6 months) with possibility of extension

South-East Ottawa Community Health Centre (SEOCHC) is a non-profit, community-governed organization that provides a range of multi-disciplinary services to clients, including primary care, health promotion, social services, community and resource development, home support and advocacy to address the social determinants of health. SEOCHC particularly responds to persons who face barriers to accessing health and social services and who live in South-East Ottawa. Our services and programs are designed to meet the needs of our community.

Our Primary Care clinic is seeking a full time Registered Nurse to work as a member of an inter-professional primary care team, which includes physicians, nurse practitioners, nurses, administrative staff, and allied health professionals. The nurse's main duties would include performing in home COVID-19 testing for clients age 6 months + and participating in COVID-19 vaccination clinics (on site and in the community).

Due to the pandemic, we conduct daily infection prevention screening of all clients and staff coming to our Centre to help prevent exposures to COVID-19. We provide both virtual and face-to-face visits to our clients.

- Registered with the College of Nurses of Ontario
- Nursing experience, preferably in a community-based setting
- Fluency in English and French language preferred; other languages an asset
- Proficiency in the use of computers and electronic medical records
- Ability to work flexible hours
