Registered Nurse, COVID-19 Response & Recovery
Full time (35 hours/week) – Contract till March 31, 2023

South-East Ottawa Community Health Centre (SEOCHC) is a non-profit, community-governed organization that provides a range of multi-disciplinary services to clients, including primary care, health promotion, social services, community and resource development, home support and advocacy to address the social determinants of health. SEOCHC particularly responds to persons who face barriers to accessing health and social services and who live in South-East Ottawa. Our services and programs are designed to meet the needs of our community.

SEOCHC has been working hard for the past two years responding to the needs of the community during the COVID-19 pandemic. The work continues as we build back in supporting our marginalized communities. Our goal is to continue to increase access to testing, vaccines, and antiviral treatment. At the same time, providing access to community mental health, primary care and preventive care and support in addressing the social determinants of health. Therefore, this role will be bringing services primarily to our communities in their backyard.

Our COVID-19 Recovery & Response Team is seeking a full-time Registered Nurse to provide care in the community in our efforts in supporting COVID-19 response and recovery. This role will work in collaboration with an interprofessional team, in the community and support clients in accessing services available across the Centre. Travel will be required across the city for this position.

We are seeking a community minded Registered Nurse to work in our community as a member of an inter-professional primary care team, which includes physicians, nurse practitioners, nurses, administrative staff, and allied health professionals.

Due the pandemic, we conduct daily infection prevention screening of all clients and staff coming to our Centre to help prevent exposures to COVID-19. We provide both virtual and face-to-face visits to our clients.

Qualifications:

- Baccalaureate in Nursing; Registered with the College of Nurses of Ontario
- Minimum of two years of RN experience, preferably in a community-based setting
- Strong clinical skills; nursing process, health education, primary prevention
- Effective organizational, critical thinking, problem-solving and decision-making skills
- Excellent communication skills and ability to adapt communication styles to meet the needs of clients, health team members and community partners

- Experience working with low-income families, children, youth, seniors, multicultural and diverse populations
- Experience working with a diverse interprofessional care team
- Knowledge and understanding of the Community Health Centre model of health and well-being
- Demonstrated understanding of the impact of the social determinants of health on people's health and well-being
- Fluency in English; other languages such as French, Arabic or Somali an asset
- Proficiency in the use of computers and electronic medical records, particularly PS Suites
- Ability to work flexible hours
- Proof of Vaccination against COVID-19 required
- Recent Police Record Check for the Vulnerable Sector required
- Must have a valid driver's license and own mode of transportation
- Basic Life Support for health care provider
